Right after the start of this road on the right, we'll pass the **Admiralty Arch** (7 ms), and further on, we'll see the official residence of the Prime Minister, at **10 Downing Street** (7 ms). We might have a chance to see the peculiar **Horse Guards** or foot guards of the building.

12:00 White Hall becomes **Parliament Street**, which leads us to **Parliament Square** (1 minute). From this place we'll get a view of the **Houses of Parliament** (3 ms) and **Big Ben** (2 ms) and on the far right we'll see **Westminster Abbev**.

13:00 We'll cross **Westminster Bridge** and on the other side we'll get the chance to take the best picture of the **Houses of Parliament** across the river **Thames.** Here we'll also see and have a ride, if you want, in the expensive **London Eye.** This is optional, and everybody will have to pay for their own tickets. Here we can have our packed lunch.

15:00 We'll take some pictures of the **Tower Bridge**. We'll take **Stamford** street (16 minutes) and have a look from this side of the river Thames. We'll continue walking and ten minutes later we'll visit the **Tate Modern.**



17:00 6 minutes from the Tate Modern we can see **Shakespeare Globe theatre.** We'll take the **Millennium bridge** towards **St Paul's cathedral**.
